# CONDITIONS FOR THE DUNCAN PUTTER

## 72 HOLES SCRATCH MEDAL PLAY

The **DUNCAN PUTTER** is a Challenge Trophy competed for annually over 72 holes at Southerndown Golf Club. The Putter remains permanently in the Clubhouse and the winner has his name engraved on the Putter Case.

### Practice Day

Competitors have courtesy of the course to practise on the day before the event.

### Day 1

Pairings and timings for the first day will be arranged in advance. There will be a 36-hole cut and the top 36 players plus ties will progress to the last 36 holes.

### Day 2

Pairings and timings for the second day will be determined by the reverse order of scores on day 1.

### PRIZES

*Sponsored by Coors*  
*- over £1,000 in prizes*

*Competitors will be expected to wear jackets and ties at the prize-giving ceremony which will be held immediately after the end of the tournament.*

**THE DUNCAN PUTTER** - the player with the lowest aggregate score over 4 rounds.

**MEDALS** - the three players with the best individual 72-hole scores.  
- the best 72-hole score by a Welsh player aged under 21.

**OTHER PRIZES** - the best score in each individual round.  
*N.B. The winners of the 72-hole medals are ineligible for these prizes.*

In the event of a tie for the Putter the result will remain as a tie. The winners will receive medals and have their names engraved on the Putter case. Ties for other medals will be decided on the best 4th round, 3rd round etc. If the winner of the under-21 medal is also overall winner of the 1st, 2nd or 3rd prizes he may take both medals. Ties for the 18-hole prizes will be awarded to the player who has the best 72-hole medal score. Any further tie will be determined by the Tournament Committee
